THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE) (ENGLAND) ORDER 2015

DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLES 18(4) AND 45 RELATING TO CREMORNE WHARF

The Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by articles 18(4) and 45 of the Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015¹, hereby directs the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea as follows:

- 1. In this Direction, "Council" means the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea.
- 2. This Direction shall come into force on 1st March 2021 and shall apply to any application for planning permission for development which is received by the Council on or after 1st March 2021 and which is for development wholly or partly within the area edged in red on the attached plan.
- 3. Before granting planning permission on any application to which this Direction applies, the Council shall consult the Mayor of London.
- 4. (1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2) below, the Directions given to the Council by the Secretary of State for Environment, Transport and the Regions on 16 June 2000 under articles 10(3) and 27 of the Town and Country Planning (General Development Procedure) Order 1995 relating to Cremorne Wharf are hereby cancelled.
 - (2) Sub-paragraph (1) does not apply to any application for planning permission which is received by the Council on or before **28**th **February 2021**.
