1. Tackling Violent Crime Update

The Mayor was provided with an update on the work of the Violent Crime Taskforce, and MOPAC's work on tackling violent crime.

2. Policing Protests

DAC Laurence Taylor briefed the Mayor on the policing of protests.

3. Brexit

The Mayor was updated on the Met's preparations for Brexit.

4. Data Sharing

The Mayor was updated on the sharing of images with third parties that had previously occurred at borough level and was advised of the current position.

5. Henriques Report/Operation Midland

The Commissioner updated the Mayor regarding the Met's plans to publish a fuller version of the Henriques report; and the anticipated publication of the Independent Office for Police Conduct's investigation.

6. HMICFRS PEEL Review

There was a discussion of the HMICFRS's PEEL assessment of the MPS which had been published that day.

7. Tasers

The Commissioner updated the Mayor on the Met's plans to increase the numbers of officers carrying Tasers, and the considerations of public and officer safety that had informed her decision.
