

London CONTEST Board Meeting Note

25 September 2019

The London CONTEST Board meeting of 25 September 2019 was chaired by the Deputy Mayor for Policing and Crime. The Board is made up of members from MOPAC, MPS, Home Office, NHS England, City of London, National Probation Service (NPS), TfL, DfE, and London Councils.

Agenda Item 1: Actions. The outstanding matters were addressed.

Agenda Item 2: Pursue. The Board was provided with a current threat briefing and additional information on recent terror related court cases.

Agenda Item 3: The Board heard updates from the MPS on a review of the process involved in monitoring hate crime reports and assessments on extremism referrals.

Agenda Item 4: The Board received updates on the work of the London Resilience Group and London's preparedness.

Agenda Item 5: Protect. The MPS updated the Board on the methodology on Crowded Spaces model.

Agenda Item 6: Prevent. The Board heard an update from the London Prevent Board, including the regionalisation programme in London.

Agenda Item 7: The MPS presented on the work of the CT Vulnerability Support Hub.

Agenda Item 8: Prevent. The Board received an update on the MAC programme.

Agenda Item 9: Prevent. MOPAC provided an update on the London CVE Programme.
